#### **OUR MODEL**

#### 9th & 10th Grade

StreetLeaders receive coaching designed to help them start high school strong academically and invest them in pursuing higher learning. Along the way, they attend their first college visits and begin to imagine themselves fitting in on a college campus

Junior Year StreetLeaders are encouraged to continue their academics with excellence, take the SAT for the first time and begin creating their "List of 7" colleges that they will plan to apply to in the fall of Senior Year

Senior StreetLeaders are coached to complete applications for at least seven colleges, apply for financial aid through completing the FAFSA, research and apply for scholarships and receive support in making a final college decision alongside their families by May 1st

StreetLeaders are supported throughout the summer after graduation leading up to the start of their college classes. We enlist the support of our Promise Coaches to help make sure each alum is cared for and set up to thrive in their new stage of life as a college student!
